### AWMA(SA) Objectives

To promote and increase awareness of wound management by:

- Ensuring a strong governance framework
- Developing and maintaining collaborative relationships with health professionals, professional bodies and key organisations/groups
- Promoting contemporary wound management
- Promoting evidence based practice, education and research
- Providing a forum for the dissemination of information to health professionals

### Key outcomes planned for 2010-2012

- Promote and maintain multidisciplinary committee representation
- Develop by-laws to support the revised AWMA(SA) constitution
- Review the format of committee meeting to ensure optimal efficiency, productivity and collegiality
- Maintain strong links with AWMA
- Participate in AWMA Structure Review
- Ensure role clarity and facilitate succession planning
- Inform relevant external bodies and key groups of AWMA(SA) and current issues related to wound management
- Develop and maintain links with like professional bodies and organisations
- Develop formal contacts with major service providers and/or groups not represented on the AWMA(SA) committee
- Develop an annual education calendar that delivers relevant, useful information
- Participate in Wound Awareness Week
- Raise awareness of AWMA(SA) and contemporary practice in regional areas
- Promote the scholarships
- Participate actively in AWMA initiatives including:
  - Development of Clinical Practice Guidelines for Venous Leg Ulcers
  - Review of the Clinical Practice Guidelines for the Prediction and Prevention of pressure ulcers
  - Development of position documents as required
- Explore new strategies to disseminate key publications, resources and information
- Maintain and expand the web site
- Hold a seminar in 2011
